

COURT ORDER # 060424-14

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2024, the Kaufman County Judge issued a Disaster Declaration declaring a state of disaster for the County of Kaufman, Texas resulting from Extremely high winds and excessive rainfall and;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist and;

WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT of the County of Kaufman, Texas:

1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for the County of Kaufman, Texas by the County Judge on May 28, 2024 shall continue for the next 45 days unless terminated by order of the Commissioner's Court.
2. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to Commissioner's Court Order dated May 1988 and shall become effective on the 4th day of June , 2024.
