Housing Choice Voucher Program Waitlist

The waitlist for Terrell's program opened on May 12 and remained open until June 9. The sign-up process has now concluded. The City received 7,731 applications. Housing will be completing a lottery for 2,000 applications before June 27.

Summer Reading "Color Our World"

- Approximately 400 individuals attended the Kickoff event. Staff from the swimming pool, WINGS Career & Testing Center, and Terrell Fire Department also attended the event.
- The event featured 25 vendors, including local churches, equine therapy, BFTS Museum, TYA and more.
- During the first week six (6) programs were conducted, with 745 participants.
- Registration totals are broken down in to two categories. For Youth (0-17), 358 registered. For Adults (18+), 112 registered, the highest number of adult registrants to date.
- The Awards Ceremony and End of Summer Pool Party, held at the City Pool, will be held Saturday, July 26. The awards presentation will be held beginning at 9:30 a.m., with swimming from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
