The City Manager's Notes for the week ending September 26, 2025, are provided below. This report contains public information and can be freely shared.

### **Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Management Response (SAFER) Grant**

On Thursday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, City staff was notified that the application submitted by the City of Terrell has been approved for award. The City has thirty (30) days from the date of award to either accept or decline the award. An item will be included on the October 7, 2025 City Council agenda authorizing the acceptance of the grant. More details will be provided as part of that presentation. Thanks to Chief LeCroy and Dustin Conner for their hard work in securing this grant. The FY26 Adopted Budget included an estimate of grant funds to cover the additional firefighters needed for Station #3.

### **Signal Timing Disruption at Highway 80 and 205/148**

It has been brought to staff's attention that the left turn signal on westbound Highway 80 at 205/148 will become unsynchronized when a train passes the intersection. It will remain red for three or more cycles of the traffic signals. Staff has brought this matter to the attention of TxDOT. When we receive additional information, we will pass it along.

### **Solid Waste Service Pilot Program Update / Service Alternatives**

Waste Connections will continue the pilot program into the Stallings Addition until they receive additional information / direction from their corporate offices. Staff is preparing an item for discussion at the October 21, 2025 City Council meeting. This discussion will include the results of the program, feedback received, and potential paths forward. At a future meeting, after the discussion item is present, staff will bring a follow up item for Council action. This will not be able to occur until after the City receives additional information from Waste Connections' corporate offices related to service fee impacts.

### **Bill Hutmacher Investiture Ceremony**

Bill Hutmacher, Chairman of the Number One British Flying Training School Museum, will be recognized for his outstanding achievements in services to the UK at a ceremony held on Friday, October 3 at the British Ambassador's Residence & Gardens in Washington D.C. He will be awarded the *British Empire Medal (BEM)* for services to the preservation of UK – US military history.

The British Empire Medal (BEM) is a British and Commonwealth award given to civilians and military personnel for meritorious service to their local community. The BEM is given for a "hands-on" contribution that has a significant impact within a local geographical area.

### **SSG Brady Berry Memorial Soccer Complex Dedication**

This is a reminder that a dedication ceremony for the SSG Brady Berry Soccer Complex will be held on Friday, October 3 at 4:00 PM. Friends and family will hold a private reception following the ceremony at 4:30 PM at the Ben Gill Par Pavilion.
